Club 420 Association National Jr. Team Race Championship**

Notice of Race

August 3-5, 2009

1. Date and Venue

The 2009 CJ Buckley/ Club 420 Association National Jr. Team Race Championship will be held with racing from Monday, August 3 through Wednesday, August 5, 2009. The venue will be the Carousel at Goddard Memorial State Park, East Greenwich, Rhode Island.

2. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS) including Appendix D, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

3. CLASS

Bring your own Club 420's. No Spinnaker or Trapeze shall be used. Mainsheet bridles are permitted.

4. TEAM

Each competing team shall consist of 3 boats, each with a skipper and crew.

5. ADVERTISING

The regatta is classified as a Category A Event in accordance with Appendix 1, Regulation 20-ISAF Advertising Code.

6. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Each competitor on a team must not reach their 19th birthday in the 2009 calendar year.

7.1 REGISTRATION

Registration is online at www.cjbuckleyregatta.net.

It is imperative that teams planning on attending notify PRO Justin Assad of their attendance at Justin.Assad@gmail.com for the purposes of creating rotation in timely fashion.

7.2 ENTRY FEE

The entry fee for this event is \$50 per participant (\$100 per boat, \$300 per team). Payments may be made online, or cash or checks will be accepted at sign-in on the first day of competition . Checks should be made payable to the “CJ Buckley Sailing Foundation”. The entry fee includes an event shirt, lunches each day, dinner on site Monday and Tuesday after racing, and event trophies.

9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Available at Competitor’s Meeting, Monday, August 3, 2009

10. FORMAT

The format will be determined based on the number of teams registered, and announced at the Competitor’s Meeting on August 3, 2009.

11. COURSES

Courses will be a digital “N”.

12. SCORING

Scoring will be in accordance with Appendix D, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to teams placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd.

14. LIFEJACKETS

All competitors shall wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved PDF at all times while on the water.

15. PROTESTS

Protests will be settled via an on the water Three Minute Justice system as outlined at the Competitor's Meeting.

16. ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

No contestant shall use either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages or use any controlled substance, the possession of which is unlawful. This regulation is in effect during the entire event, from the time of check in through the completion of all activities and departure from the premises.

17. LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
